**Award-winning Script *No More* adapted for theater!  
Actor's Mission Brings Life to Author's Vision**

The Rock Springs Actor's Mission proudly presents their theatrical adaptation of S.P. Wright's *No More*. This adaptation marks the first of Wright's scripts to be presented live as well as the first in the Actor's Mission series on local writers.

*No More* follows Paul; a struggling artist who has lost his inspiration and his motivation after moving his brother and family into his home. A naive man who believes in the golden rule, Paul is faced with the ugly truth of his family when his partner passes away and the family is "inconvenienced" by the situation. He must decide what is truly most important in life; his responsibility to his family, or his own self-respect.

There are certain roles that exist within all families. Paul attempts to be the patriarch, the older brother, the uncle, and the breadwinner (among others). Stretching himself beyond the limits of his abilities he slowly realizes the extent to which he has allowed himself to fall; and how little control he now has over his life!

The story is a work of creative non-fiction and based on events that took place in Rock Springs during the late 1990s. The story touches upon the overwhelming weight of depression and the personal detachment from the world that comes with it. It explores the ideas of "tough love" through the primary characters and their differing ideals on familial support. The core of the tale centers around the message that not all "negative events" must have "negative" outcomes.

The Actor's Mission of Rock Springs endeavors to bring awareness to local artists and their unique offerings. Aware of and frustrated with the continuing reduction of support for art programs the members of the Actor's Mission crafted the "Local Draft". Cunningly named for the versions of creation from conception to presentation, this program encouraged all local writers to bring forth a script for consideration. Fifteen scripts were chosen for adaptation throughout the summer.
